Equitation 13 and Under: Exhibitors to enter the ring as a group. Exhibitors to be judged at the walk, trot (sitting and posting), and canter, both ways of the ring. The judge may request additional patterns to be ridden. Exhibitors to be under the age of 13 years on January 1, 2010. Exhibitors will be judged on their position, seat, and effective use of aids. The judge may ask for any movement from the USEF Training or First level tests. Dressage dress and saddlery are required.

Equitation 14-17: Exhibitors to enter the ring as a group. Exhibitors to be judged at the walk, trot (sitting and posting), and canter, both ways of the ring. The judge may request additional patterns to be ridden. Exhibitors to be between the ages 14 years and have not had their 18th birthday on January 1, 2010. Exhibitors will be judged on their position, seat, and effective use of aids. The judge may ask for any movement from the USEF training or first level tests. Dressage dress and saddlery are required.

Costume Class ~ \$10 to all competitors. Administrative/office fees, ring fees, and non-member fees are waived for competitors that are ONLY entering the costume class. Costume class to be held at the lunch break, approximately 12:30pm.

USDF Intro tests -- \$25.00

Equitation Classes --\$15.00

Costume Class--\$10.00 (**If **only** entering costume class, **all** other fees are waived).

All other tests -- \$40.00

This is a CDS recognized show. Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current US Equestrian Rule Book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith. CDS rules and regulations apply. All tests will be ridden in a standard size arena.

****Competitors riding in USDF Intro Tests A & B may enter the equitation classes but may not cross enter in USEF classes.**

Entries will not be accepted before the opening date and must be received by the entry deadline. **All entries must be complete and accompanied by all fees, copies of cards and signatures.** Entries that are received with missing information, not signed or without complete payment will not be accepted. This will be strictly enforced. Incomplete entries will be returned and the priority of the entry will be the date of resubmission of the completed entry. Entries are accepted on a first come, first serve basis. One horse per entry form. If necessary, riders may be limited to two classes. Please list classes in order of preference. A \$10 fee may be charged for clerical changes. A \$50 fee will be assessed if a check bounces. No refunds after closing date. Before the closing date, refunds for will be made only for veterinarian or medical reasons if requested in writing within 5 business days of the closing date accompanied by a veterinarian or doctor's note, after deducting a \$25 handling fee.

Trophies and ribbons will be awarded in all classes. Training and First level class awards will be divided Open, A/A, and Jr/YR. All other classes will be divided if entries warrant. High Point Open, AA, and Jr/YR will be awarded to the highest score earned in a USEF class. To have scores from this show count towards end of the year SNC awards, rider must be an SNC member on the date of the show. Scores earned at this show can be counted towards the 2011 CDS RAAC, Junior/YR and Annual show championships.

CDS members who participate in a CDS recognized show may not be required to pay nonmember fees to any other organization (National Federation- US EQUESTRIAN or National Breed Organizations exempted) in order to participate in the show. For CDS recognized shows in California, Nevada, Arizona and Oregon, CDS agrees to a reciprocal non-member system where CDS will waive the non-member fee IF the competitor and/or owner is a member of another USDF GMO; and in return **the show management will not charge CDS members a non-member fee for any other GMO.** If the competitor and/or owner is not a member of CDS or any other GMO, then the show management will charge and collect non-member fees for CDS.

Entry forms must indicate chapter affiliation (SNC, Reno chapter, etc.) and whether or not the rider is a junior or young rider.

Ride times will be POSTED ON THE SNC WEB SITE at www.snc-cds.com 3 days before the show. If you do not have computer access or are unable to get your ride times via the web site, please call the show manager. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to obtain ride times. Failure to enter the arena on time will result in elimination.

GR1401 (Article 1401.9) Requirements. (Approved EC 12/21/04 Effective 1/1/05) 9. The following statement must be published in BOLD TYPE for all Regular Competitions; Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above, Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage Competitions, Endurance Rides and Vaulting Competitions: **LIFE, SENIOR ACTIVE AND JUNIOR ACTIVE MEMBERS SHALL BE ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE IN ALL CLASSES AT REGULAR COMPETITIONS, EVENTING COMPETITIONS AT THE PRELIMINARY LEVEL OR ABOVE AND COMBINED DRIVING COMPETITIONS AT THE ADVANCED LEVEL, DRESSAGE AND VAULTING COMPETITIONS AND ENDURANCE RIDES PROVIDED THE RESPECTIVE BREED/DISCIPLINE DUES OR BREED/DISCIPLINE CATEGORY FEE HAS BEEN PAID. A NON-MEMBER MAY PARTICIPATE AS A HANDLER, RIDER, DRIVER, OWNER, LESSEE, AGENT, COACH OR TRAINER AT REGULAR COMPETITIONS, EVENTING COMPETITIONS, DRESSAGE COMPETITIONS AND COMBINED DRIVING COMPETITIONS UPON PAYMENT OF A \$20. NONMEMBER REGISTRATION FEE AND A \$5. BREED/DISCIPLINE CATEGORY FEE FOR EACH BREED/DISCIPLINE. PARTICIPANTS IN THE FOLLOWING CLASSES ARE EXEMPTED FROM THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS RULE; 1) LEADLINE; 2) EXHIBITIONS; 3) GAMES AND RACES; 4) CLASSES FOR 4-H MEMBERS; 5) WALK TROT AND ACADEMY CLASSES (Academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF INTRODUCTORY LEVEL TESTS, PAS DE DEUX AND QUADRILLE CLASSES. ALSO EXEMPTED FROM THIS REQUIREMENT ARE CITIZENS OF OTHER NATIONS WHO HAVE PROOF, IN ENGLISH, OF CURRENT MEMBERSHIP IN GOOD STANDING OF THEIR OWN NATIONAL FEDERATION 7) USEA BEGINNER NOVICE DIVISION, AND 8) ASSISTANT HANDLERS IN DRESSAGE SPORT HORSE BREEDING CLASSES.**

Every class offered herein which is covered by the Rules and specifications of the current USEF Rule Book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.

USEF GR1301.5: Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds or recognized competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Rule 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

Dogs are not permitted to be loose on competition grounds and must be on a leash or otherwise contained. Individuals must not lead dogs on a leash while mounted. Dog owners failing to comply with this rule may be subject to penalty under Chapters 6 and 7, as well as issuance of warning cards.
